What is Simpli5?

Are you happy with your smile? Have you been dreaming of perfecting your smile yet dreading years of intrusive braces?

Simpli5 is a system of clear aligners similar to invisalign which is used to treat mild orthodontic problems. Simpli5 derived its name since it is a five-aligner orthodontic system (ie only requires 5 aligners in total).

What can the Simpli5 system be used for?

~minor tooth gaps that need to be closed ~those who require minor adjustments following more extensive braces treatment.

~following orthodontic treatment many people forget to wear their retainers and teeth begin to move back towards their original position.

How long does treatment with the Simpli5 system take?

The treatment time depends on the amount of tooth movement required but typically treatment times are between 10 - 20 weeks.

What is the procedure of Simpli5

1. Following an initial consultation with Dr Molin to assess your suitability for the system, she will take impressions of your teeth and send them to the Simpli5 laboratory.

2. Your teeth moulds will be used as a template to fabricate your simpli5 clear aligners. 3. You will wear each set of aligners for 3-4 weeks for about 20 hours a day removing them to eat and clean your teeth. You will know when it is time to change to your next set of aligners when your aligners begin to feel loose.

4. Once your final sets of aligners have been worn for 3-4 weeks you have completed treatment and you should have straight teeth.

It's as simple as that!
